BCARL's mission is to provide help to the county's animals with support through grants to local animal welfare groups, providing spay neuter assistance (SNAP) and emergency vet care to those with financial need, and providing dog and cat food to community food pantries.

With the help of Compassionate Cat Care Clinic and Barnesville Veterinary Service, Belmont County resident cat spay/neuters will be paid by BCARL until funds run out. BCARL will cover the cost, however, we ask that residents pay what they can to enable more cats to have the procedure.
